

Support in Decisions Around Art and Culture

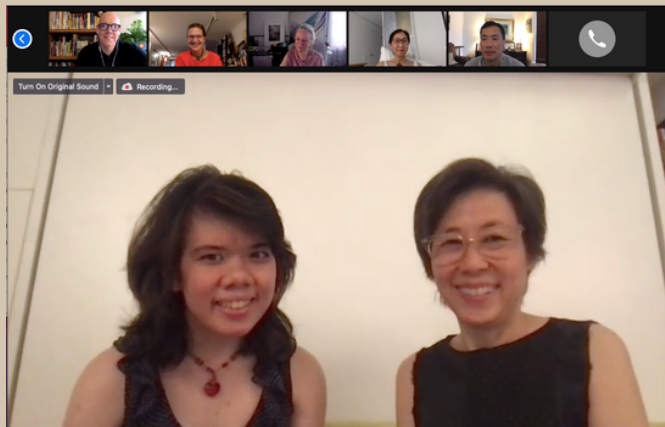
